

COVID-19 RAPID ANTIBODY TEST

Employers have always played a role in the health and safety of their employees. During this pandemic, employers have an opportunity to embrace this pivotal role and fight against COVID-19 and the impact it has in our community.

Offering antibody testing is a safety measure to help identify staff who have already recovered from COVID-19 and are less likely to contract the virus and continue to spread it throughout the workplace.

What is the COVID-19 Rapid Antibody Test?

- Instant finger-stick detects the presence of antibodies within 10 minutes
- Measures amount of antibodies/protein in the blood when body is responding to an infection (i.e. COVID-19)

What Do the Results Mean?

- Positive results indicate current and/or past exposure to COVID-19
- Negative results indicate:
 - a. Employee has not been exposed to the virus COVID-19
 - b. Employee might have been exposed but has not yet produced antibodies against COVID-19

Who Should Receive Test?

Symptomatic employees, should contact primary care physician for further instructions on testing

Asymptomatic employees:

- To determine if a patient might be a carrier of COVID-19
- To determine if a patient has been infected with COVID-19 in the past and has developed immunity
